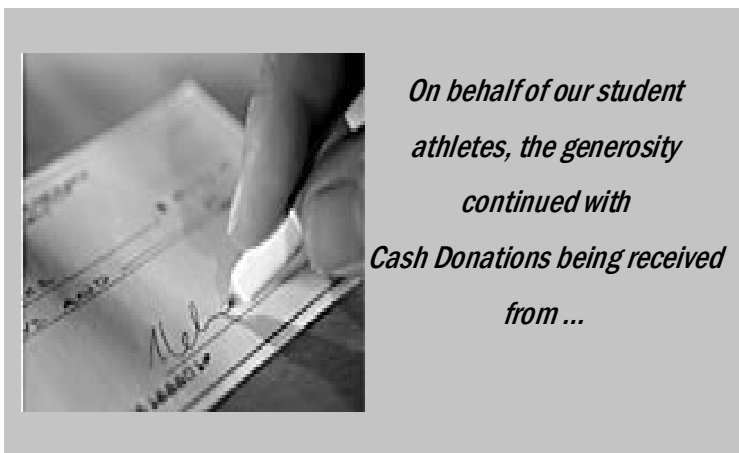
Teams raise \$\$ for their own programs...
